Second-Round Notes - Friday, July 6, 2018

Weather: Mostly cloudy, with a high of 77. Wind WNW 4-8 mph. Due to inclement weather, the start to round two was delayed 30 minutes, from 7:00 a.m. until 7:30 a.m. Afternoon tee times were unaffected.

36-hole cut: 77 professionals at 3-under 137 from a field of 154 professionals and two amateurs

Six Things To Know

- Kelly Kraft takes 36-hole lead with a career-low 63
- Anirban Lahiri shoots career-low 61
- Anirban Lahiri and Jason Kokrak are the only two players bogey-free through 36 holes
- At 5-under 135 (66-69), Greenbrier Resort Ambassador Phil Mickelson makes second cut in fifth start in the event
- Greenbrier resident Bubba Watson is 6-under 134 (68-66), seven strokes back
- Special Temporary Member Joaquin Niemann is 8-under 132 after scores of 63-69, five strokes back

1 Start at A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier

- In second start at A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier, made eight birdies and one bogey (par-5 12th)
- Needing only 24 putts in round two, leads the field in Strokes Gained: Putting (+6.664)
- Only previous lead/co-lead after any round on TOUR was round one of the 2017 Fort Worth Invitational (finished T18)
- Posted scores of 67-66-67-69—269 (-11) to finish T5 in this event last season
- Comes to this week's event after missed cuts in seven of his last 10 starts
- Has collected two top-10 finishes this season; T8/The Honda Classic, 3rd/Corales Puntacana Resort & Club Championship

Anirban Lahiri (-12/T2)

- Made nine birdies and no bogeys en route to a career-low 9-under 61 (in relation to par). Previous best was 8-under 64 (R2/2017 CIMB Classic/T10)
- Hit all 18 greens in regulation in round two and is 31/36 through two rounds. Marks the second time he has hit all 18 greens in regulation (R1/2016 CareerBuilder Challenge)
- In the 20 rounds leading up to this week, is a cumulative 37-under par. In the 18-round span prior to that stretch, was a collective 31-over par
- Making his first start in A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier
- Remains in search of first PGA TOUR win in 78th start. Best result is T2/2017 the Memorial Tournament
- In 18 starts this season before this week, collected top-10 finishes at the CIMB Classic (T10), THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES (T5) and Travelers Championship (T9)
- Has collected 18 international victories

Webb Simpson (-12/T2)

- Followed a birdie at his first hole of the day, No. 10, with a double bogey at the par-5 12th and a bogey at the par-4 13th
- At 2-over through four holes in his second round, rallied with birdies at Nos. 16, 4, 5, 7 and 8 to finish with a 3-under 67
- In seven previous starts at A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier, finished inside the top 10 in 2011 (T9), 2012 (T7) and 2014 (3rd). Finished T14 last season
- In three starts since winning THE PLAYERS Championship in May, has missed two cuts (Fort Worth Invitational, Travelers Championship). Finished T10 at the U.S. Open
- In addition to TPC Sawgrass victory, claimed top-5 finishes this season at the Sony Open in Hawaii (T4), The Honda Classic (T5) and RBC Heritage (T5)

Jason Kokrak (-11/4th)

- Follows a bogey-free 5-under 65 with a bogey-free 64 in round two
- Has missed just two greens in regulation through 36 holes (No. 1 in R1, No. 17 in R2)
- Making his fifth start in A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier; 2012/MC, 2013/T41, 2015/T54, 2017/MC
- Comes into the week on the heels of three straight missed cuts
- Remains in search of first PGA TOUR title in 179th start
- Claimed runner-up finishes at the 2012 Safeway Open and 2016 Genesis Open
- Best of three top-10 finishes in 2017-18 season is T7 at the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship
