Today – A weak cold front will sag southward and stall across Southern Georgia/Northern Florida today. This will produce partly cloudy skies across Central Florida this afternoon. Any shower chances will remain across Northern Florida closer to the front. Otherwise, above normal temperatures will continue today with highs likely reaching the mid 80's with a light westerly breeze.

Extended forecast – Warm and humid conditions can be expected Monday with highs in the mid 80's. Can't rule out an isolated shower or t-storm during the afternoon hours but the best chances will be to the north of Orlando. Otherwise, a better chance for showers and t-storms will arrive on Tuesday as a cold front moves across the state. This may produce a line of severe t-storms Tuesday afternoon with strong winds, lightning and heavy rainfall.
