ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jordan Spieth

Jordan Spieth picked up his ninth PGA TOUR victory becoming the second youngest player to win nine times on TOUR since WWII (Tiger Woods (23,5) 1999 Memorial Tournament, Jack Nicklaus (24) 1964 WMPO)). Spieth moved from 16th to third in the FedExCup standings with his win at the 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

On Pebble Beach GL (two rds), Jordan Spieth outperformed the field by +2.124 strokes on the greens in SG: Putting. In round three, Jordan only needed 23 putts, which marked the 17th time in his career where he had 23 or fewer putts in a round on TOUR.

Jordan Spieth tied with Dustin Johnson for the most victories since the start of the 2013 PGA TOUR season (11). Jordan recorded his ninth victory in his 100th professional start on TOUR at this event last year. Since the 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach-Pro Am, Spieth picked up his 10th career victory at (2017 Travelers Championship) and 11th career victory (2017 Open).

Last season, all three courses at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am ranked inside the top-five in shortest course on the PGA TOUR. Pebble Beach GL (host course) was the shortest course on TOUR playing at 6,816 yards (scorecard yardage).

Last season, the field averaged 264.9 yards from the tee, ranking as the shortest Driving Distance (all drives) of any course. Pebble Beach GL was one of two courses (Stadium Course) where the field hit less than 10.0% of the drives over 300 yards. Players hit 8.96% (of) of the total drives over 300 yards at Pebble Beach GL during the 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Last season, two of the three courses at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am ranked inside the top-five in Easiest Fairways to hit.

Monterey Peninsula CC ranked as the easiest course to find the fairway with players hitting the fairway **75.02%** of the time and Pebble Beach GL ranked third on TOUR last season (**74.03%**).

Last season, Monterey Peninsula CC had the lowest One-Putt Percentage of any course (31.67%) and was one of five courses where the field averaged less than 35.0% in one putts.

Five of the eight winners of this event that advanced to the TOUR Championship finished the season inside the top-five of the FedExCup that season.

1,695 Points: Since 2009, Dustin Johnson has earned 1,695 FedExCup points at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am, marking the most FedExCup points earned of any player at this event.

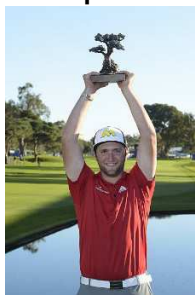

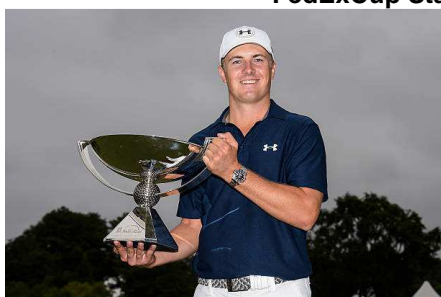

Jordan Spieth hit 18 of his last 20 GIR's to close out his win at the 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. For the week, Spieth hit 57 of 72 greens in regulation marking the 2nd most GIR's en route to victory of his 11 wins on TOUR.

Matt Kuchar

Matt Kuchar is set to make his fourth start of the 2017-18 PGA TOUR season and 12th at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. Matt is coming off a T5 place finish at last week's Waste Management Phoenix Open and currently ranks 77th in the FedExCup standings.

Kuchar is one of two players (Paul Casey) that have advanced to the TOUR Championship without a victory in each of the last three seasons.

Jon Rahm

Jon Rahm currently ranks second in the FedExCup standings on the strength of one win (CareerBuilder Challenge), two top-10s and three top-25 finishes this season. Since the start of last season, no other player has been inside the top-10 after any round in a stroke play event on TOUR than Jon Rahm. Jon Rahm has been inside of the top-10 of the leaderboard a total of 46 times.

Gary Woodland

Gary Woodland is coming off his third PGA TOUR win at last week's Waste Management Phoenix Open. Gary is set to make his fourth start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am. Woodland's best finish at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am came last year where he finished T5.

At this event last year, Gary Woodland posted his best rounds three & four cumulative score to par on TOUR since the 2012 PGA TOUR season. Woodland went from a T56 after round two to T5 finish after a 12-under par weekend at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Woodland recorded nine birdies in the final round marking the sixth time where he has made 10 or more birdies in a round on TOUR. Gary Woodland was the first winner since Russell Henley (2017 Houston Open, 10 birdies) to make nine or more birdies in a final round and go onto win.

Adam Scott

Adam Scott is set to make his 284th start of his PGA TOUR career and his third start this season. Adam Scott's last start came at the WGC-HSBC Champions in October. Adam Scott currently ranks 160th in the FedExCup standings, in his only start at the AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am he finished T52.

Dustin Johnson has recorded his last 11 seasons (including this season) on TOUR with at least one victory. 2016 FedExCup Champion, Rory McIlroy is set to make his first start of the 2017-18 PGA TOUR season this week. Rory is making his AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am debut, the last event on TOUR where he competed for the first time was the 2017 Travelers Championship where he finished T17.
