- **14** players in the Barracuda Championship field are ranked inside of the top 100 of the FedExCup standings.
- J.J. Spaun (53<sup>rd</sup>) is the highest ranked player in the field and can likely crack the top 30 with a victory this week.
- **27 of the top 125** players in the FedExCup are in the field at the Barracuda Championship and are seeking to improve their position in the FedExCup standings.
- **56** players are in the field who rank from 126 to 200 seeking to make a move into the top 125 this week.

17 players in the field at the Barracuda Championship ranked inside the top 125 last season who are currently outside of the top 125 this season.

Bill Haas (35<sup>th</sup>) was the highest ranked player last season who is currently outside the top 125 in the field this week. The 2011 FedExCup Champion is in danger of missing the FedExCup playoffs for the first time in his career. In fact, Bill Haas is 1 of 13 players who have qualified for the FEC Playoffs in every season since the start of the FedExCup (2007).

The highest ranked player in the FedExCup at the Barracuda Championship is **J.J. Spaun**. Spaun has made a vast improvement in his career on TOUR especially in the last 2 seasons. After finishing 97<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup last season, J.J. Spaun currently ranks 53<sup>rd</sup> this season and has already recorded as many top-10s and top-25s as he did in all of last season.

Last week, **Robert Garrigus** (currently 126<sup>th</sup>) moved from 131<sup>st</sup> to 126<sup>th</sup> in the FEC standings with a T22 at the RBC Canadian Open. Last season, Garrigus made a late charge recording three top-10 finishes in his last three regular season starts making the FEC Playoffs for the ninth time. Garrigus moved from 137<sup>th</sup> to 96<sup>th</sup> in his last three events of the regular season (entering playoffs).

Entering this week, **-0.217** points separate the 125<sup>th</sup> and 126<sup>th</sup> position in the FedExCup.

**Vaughn Taylor** is the only past champion of this event who currently ranks inside of the top 125 of the FedExCup standings. In fact, Vaughn entered this event last season in the same position and finished T-29<sup>th</sup> and moved up one position to 118<sup>th</sup> after the 2017 Barracuda Championship.

From 2013 to this season (excluding 2016 played earlier due to Olympics), J.J. Henry & Aaron Baddeley have found themselves in a similar position entering the Barracuda Championship. Henry and Baddeley have ranked 126<sup>th</sup> to 150<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings more times than any other players. 2015 Barracuda Champion has qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs two times when in this position.
