**Today** – A moderate Santa Ana wind event sets up today. This will push temperatures to around 80 degrees along the coast. E-NE winds this morning will remain light and increase to 10-20 mph during the afternoon. Much stronger winds can be expected inland along the coastal foothills and favored canyons and passes with gusts up to 55mph.

**Extended forecast** – High pressure moves further inland on Monday that will gradually weaken the Santa Ana wind event. Temperatures will remain well above normal with highs around 80 degrees at the coast and much warmer inland. Cooling will return Tuesday into Wednesday as the flow become more on-shore.
