Six Things to Know

- Taking a four-stroke lead to the par-4 18th hole, Dustin Johnson holed his second shot from 169 yards for an eagle to finish with a final-round 66 and six-stroke win at the FedEx St. Jude Classic, his second career victory at TPC Southwind (2012). The win moves Johnson back to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking after a four-week hiatus.
- Johnson's second victory of the season also moves him from No. 8 to No. 2 in the FedExCup standings behind Justin Thomas, who has held the top spot for the past 16 weeks. Johnson first won the Sentry Tournament of Champions.
- 54-hole co-leader Andrew Putnam made a double bogey on his first hole of the day en route to a 2-over 72 and runner-up finish, his best career result on the PGA TOUR.
- With a final-round 67, J.B. Holmes jumped from a tie for 10th into solo third to secure his second top-5 finish of the season.
- Stewart Cink (T4) collected his first top-10 finish on the PGA TOUR since last year's FedEx St. Jude Classic (T10).
- World Golf Hall of Fame Member Phil Mickelson rebounded in the final round with six birdies and one bogey for a 5-under 65 to finish T12.

- Collects his 18th PGA TOUR victory in his 232nd career start at 33 years, 11 months and 19 days old.
- Beginning with a share of the 54-hole lead, jumped to a three-stroke advantage after the first three holes. His lead never shrunk to less than two strokes for the remainder of the round.
- Has won at least once in each of his 11 seasons on the PGA TOUR. His victory at the FedEx St. Jude Classic marks the third consecutive season with multiple victories on the PGA TOUR (2/2017-18, 4/2016-17, 3/2015-16).
- After collecting his 17th TOUR victory at this season's Sentry Tournament of Champions, he now becomes the sixth multiple winner in the 2017-18 PGA TOUR Season (Justin Thomas, Patton Kizzire, Jason Day, Justin Rose, Bubba Watson).
- Earned his fourth career top-10 finish in six starts at the FedEx St. Jude Classic (1/2012, T10/2013, 5/2016, 1/2018).
- Became the seventh player with two or more victories at the FedEx St. Jude Classic, joining Daniel Berger (2016, '17), Justin Leonard (2005, '08), David Toms (2003, '04), Nick Price (1993, '98), Lee Trevino (1971, '72, '80) and Dave Hill (1967, '69, '70, '73).
- His 19-under winning total eclipsed his 2012 mark by 10 shots (-9).

- The win is Johnson's seventh top-10 finish of the season, tying him with Brian Harman for most top-10s on the PGA TOUR in 2017-18.
- In 10 stroke-play events this season, Johnson hasn't finished outside the top 20, with his lowest finish coming at THE PLAYERS Championship (T17).
- Before Johnson's hole-out for eagle on the 72nd hole, the last time a player holed out from off the green to win on the PGA TOUR was Jordan Spieth at the 2017 Travelers Championship.
- Ranked first in Strokes Gained: Tee to Green (+16.922).
- Hit 30 of 56 fairways, 49 of 72 greens and needed 104 putts for the week.
- Johnson will look to become the first player to win a PGA TOUR event and the U.S. Open the following week.

Additional Player Notes

Andrew Putnam (2nd)

- Had just one bogey through 54 holes (par-4 fifth/R2) before making double bogey on the first hole in the final round. Added another bogey on the par-4 fifth before converting his only birdie of the round at the par-4 seventh.
- Solo runner-up result represents his third top-10 finish of the season and his career-best finish on the PGA TOUR in 44 starts.
- Jumped from No. 107 to No. 49 in the FedExCup standings.
- Finished second in Driving Accuracy, hitting 40 of 56 fairways in regulation.
- Finished eighth on the 2017 Web.com Tour Regular Season money list to earn his way back to the PGA TOUR for the first time since the 2014-15 season.

J.B. Holmes (3rd)

- Carded a 3-under 67 to collect his second top-5 finish of the season (4th/Farmers Insurance Open).
- Recorded his ninth consecutive round under par on the PGA TOUR, dating to his final-round 66 at the AT&T Byron Nelson.
- Best finish in three previous starts in the FedEx St. Jude Classic was a T19 (2012).
- Four-time PGA TOUR winner remains in search of his first victory since the 2015 Houston Open.

Stewart Cink (T4)

- Eagled the par-5 16th after his second shot from 216 yards landed five feet from the hole.
- Recorded his first top-10 finish on the PGA TOUR since last year's FedEx St. Jude Classic.
- In his 10th start in the event, collected his third top-10 finish (T5/2004, T10/2017, T4/2018).

Richy Werenski (T4)

- Logged his first top-10 finish on the PGA TOUR in his 23rd start this season.
- Moves inside the top 125 in the FedExCup standings from No. 143 to No. 115.
- Best finish on TOUR since falling in a playoff to Chris Stroud at the 2017 Barracuda Championship in the Modified Stableford scoring format.

Phil Mickelson (T12)

- His 5-under 65 was tied for the low round of the day with Austin Cook and Tim Herron.
