ShotLink Keys to Victory for Bryson DeChambeau

Bryson DeChambeau recorded his first PGA TOUR victory in his 40th career start. DeChambeau moved from 114th to 34th in the FedExCup standings. **Final Round Back nine 30:** Bryson DeChambeau was the 16th winner (since 2010 stroke play events) on TOUR to record a 30 in the final round on the back 9 and go onto win. His 30 was the t-lowest back nine score last season (Jon Rahm Farmers).
