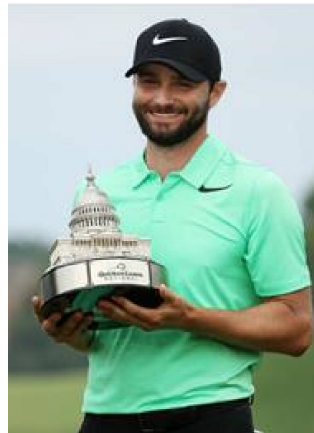


2018 Quicken Loans National Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



ShotLink Keys to Victory for Kyle Stanley

Kyle Stanley moved from 38th to 14th in the FedExCup standings, ranking inside the top 15 in the standings for the 24th week in his career. This marked the first time Kyle has ranked inside the top 15 of the FedExCup standings since week #28 of the 2012 PGA TOUR season.

Stanley recorded his second career PGA TOUR title in his 179th start at the age of 29. Kyle Stanley led the field in SG: Off-the-Tee, outperforming the field by +1.464 strokes per round.

For the week, Stanley gained strokes on 43 of 56 tee shots in SG: Off-the-Tee. Kyle ranked 52nd in SG: Putting losing -0.276 strokes per round to the field, marking just the second player last season to lose strokes in SG: Putting and go onto win (Jason Dufner - the Memorial).

Kyle Stanley's SG: Off-the-Tee performance was his third-best performance in an event of his career. His performance was the second-best by a winner on TOUR last season (4 measured rounds).

FedExCup Storylines

Last week at the Travelers Championship, Stewart Cink recorded his 11th second-place finish and second consecutive top-five finish this season. Cink moved 31 positions in the FedExCup standings from 103rd to 72nd, marking the biggest move in the standings.

Since 2007, 11 of 11 Quicken Loans National champions have qualified for the BMW Championship with nine of the 11 advancing to the TOUR Championship.

Tiger Woods (2009) is the only player to win the Quicken Loans National and the FedExCup title in the same season.

Defending Quicken Loans National champion Kyle Stanley finished 24th in the final FedExCup standings last season.

72nd in FedExCup standings: Stewart Cink enters the Quicken Loans National ranked 72nd in the FedExCup standings. Since 2012, the average FedExCup rank of the eventual Quicken Loans National champion is 72nd with the winners improving an average of 48.3 positions in the standings with the win.

Last season, players managed to salvage par 29.11% of the time when missing the green on the 11th hole at TPC Potomac at Avenel Farm, marking the fifth toughest scrambling hole.

Tiger Woods

79-time PGA TOUR winner and two-time Quicken Loan National Champion Tiger Woods is set to make his seventh start at this event. Woods currently ranks 61st in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two top 10s and six top-25 finishes.

Bill Haas

2011 FedExCup champion and 2013 Quicken Loans National Champion Bill Haas is set to make his 10th start at this event.

Bill Haas ranked second in the field in Strokes Gained: Putting, outperforming the field by +2.491 strokes per round on the greens en route to victory at the 2013 Quicken Loans National.

Marc Leishman

Marc Leishman is set to make his ninth appearance at the Quicken Loans National. Leishman currently ranks 21st in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two runner-up finishes (THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES & AT&T Byron Nelson).

In his last 137 starts on TOUR, Marc Leishman has shown consistency. He has totaled two wins, 16 top five's and 19 top 10s and a career-best sixth place finish in the FedExCup last season compared to his first 104 events on TOUR where he recorded six top five's and nine top 10s.

This season, Marc Leishman is a combined 45-under par in the first and second rounds, 30 combined strokes better than in the third and final round.

Leishman has held four leads/co-leads in the first two rounds, marking the second-most First and Second round leads/co-leads of any player this season (Dustin Johnson, 6).

Defending Quicken Loans National champion Kyle Stanley is set to make his sixth start at this event. Stanley currently ranks 34th in the FedExCup standings on the strength four top 10s and 10 top-25 finishes.

Stanley started the final round of the 2017 Quicken Loans National with a bogey on his opening hole en route to a four-under par 66, marking just the eighth time in his career to shoot four-under or better after opening a round with a bogey or worse.

Kyle Stanley ranked T3 in Driving Accuracy hitting 71.4% of his fairways compared to the field average of 56.8%. Stanley led the field for Greens in Regulation for the fourth time in his career, hitting his mark 76.4%, 16.6% more than the field average (59.8%).

Last season, Kyle Stanley ranked T3 in Driving Accuracy, hitting his mark 71.4% of the time (40 of 56). When breaking down his club used off the tee, Stanley hit 63.9% (23 of 36) of the fairways when using Driver and 83.3% (15 of 18) when using a Fairway Wood from the tee.

Billy Hurley III

2016 Quicken Loans National champion Billy Hurley III is set to make his seventh start at this event. Hurley joined Troy Merritt (2015) as the only first-time winners of the Quicken Loans National. Billy Hurley III currently ranks 210th in the FedExCup standings. In 2016, Billy Hurley III ranked 198th in the standings and marked the fifth lowest ranked player in the standings to win on TOUR since 2009.

Nick Watney

Nick Watney currently ranks 87th in the FedExCup standings on the strength of one top 10 (T2 Wells Fargo Championship) and two top-25 finishes this season. Nick Watney is seeking to make it to the TOUR Championship for the first time since the 2013 PGA TOUR season.

Cink is coming off a T2 finish at last week's Travelers Championship marking his best finish on TOUR since his last win (2009 Open Championship). Since 2012, the average FedExCup rank of the eventual champion of the Quicken Loans National is 72nd, Stewart Cink currently ranks 72nd in the standings.
