Today – Clouds will be on the increase this morning as a strong cold front approaches the area from the west. Southerly winds ahead of the front will increase to 15-25 gusting to 35-40mph by midday early afternoon. A line of strong t-storms will likely reach Hilton Head mid to late afternoon and has the potential to produce damaging winds, isolated tornadoes, and heavy rainfall.
