## ShotLink Keys to Victory for Justin Thomas

Justin Thomas picked up his second win of the 2016-17 PGA TOUR season, moving to second in the FedExCup standings with his victory at the 2017 Sentry Tournament of Champions. At the time of his win, Thomas was 23 years old and was the fourth player with three or more PGA TOUR victories before turning 24 in the FedExCup Era (Spieth 8, Mcllroy - 6 \& Reed - 3).

This stretch of 31 greens including going a perfect 18 of 18 in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ round marking the first time in his career where he had hit every green in a round on the PGA TOUR.

Last season, the Plantation Course at Kapalua was one of eight courses that the field averaged over 30.0 putts per round. There were 3,928 putts in 128 rounds played (30.69), marking the second highest putts per round of any course on TOUR.

Since 2003, four players have completed the Hawaii Slam, winning at the Sentry TOC and the Sony Open (Els, Singh, Thomas, \& Z. Johnson). Justin Thomas joined Ernie Els (2003) as the only two players to complete the Hawaii Slam in a single season.

## Keys to Victory: 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship

 Ryan Armour earned his $1^{\text {st }}$ career victory on the PGA TOUR at the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship.84.3\% of Ryan's total strokes gained for the week were a result of both his approach the green and putting performances at the CC of Jackson.

Ryan Armour became the $28^{\text {th }}$ winner (since 2004) to rank inside the top- 3 in SG: Approach-the-Green \& Putting en route to victory.

Armour's performance on the back 9 was phenomenal making 273' $10^{\prime \prime}$ in total putts and outperformed the field by +7.05 in SG: Putting. Armour's 441' $3^{\text {" }}$ total feet of putts made was the $12^{\text {th }}$ most by a winner in the ShotLink era.

264 Yards from the Tee: Ryan Armour ranked $74^{\text {th }}$ (out of 75 players) for driving distance (all drives) en route to his victory at the Sanderson Farms Championship. His 264.0 average drive from the tee is the shortest ever recorded by a winner at the Sanderson Farms Championship since 2003. Ryan Armour chose to lay-up on 17 of 20 ( $85 \%$ ) going for it holes at CC of Jackson, marking the $3^{\text {rd }}$ highest lay-up percentage among winners on TOUR since 2003.

## Daniel Berger

Daniel Berger is set to make his second start at the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2017-T14). Berger finished $16^{\text {th }}$ in the final FedExCup standings, marking his third consecutive season advancing to the TOUR Championship and is one of nine players to advance to the TOUR Championship in each of the last three seasons.

Keys to Victory: 2017 FedEx St. Jude Classic: Daniel Berger earned his $2^{\text {nd }}$ PGA TOUR victory in his $74^{\text {th }}$ start on TOUR at the 2017 FedEx St. Jude Classic. Berger ranked second in Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee, outperforming the field by +1.153 strokes per round. Berger backed up his solid play off the tee with ranking $12^{\text {th }}$ in SG: Approach-the-Green.

Jhonattan Vegas is set to make his third start at the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2012-27 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ \& 2017-T30). Vegas finished $23^{\text {rd }}$ in the final FedExCup standings, marking his career best finish in the FedExCup and is one of 14 players to advance to the TOUR Championship in each of the last two seasons.

## Keys to Victory: 2017 RBC Canadian Open

Jhonattan Vegas' final round in 2016 was very similar to his final round at the RBC Canadian Open last season. The biggest difference between the two were his performance on the greens. Vegas made over 70 feet more of putts than his final round at the 2016 RBC Canadian Open.
