

## 2018 Sentry Tournament of Champions Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Justin Thomas

Justin Thomas picked up his second win of the 2016-17 PGA TOUR season, moving to second in the FedExCup standings with his victory at the 2017 Sentry Tournament of Champions. At the time of his win, Thomas was 23 years old and was the fourth player with three or more PGA TOUR victories before turning 24 in the FedExCup Era (Spieth - 8, McIlroy - 6 & Reed - 3).

43% of Justin's total strokes gained came from his performance off-the-tee. For the week, he outperformed the field by +1.225 strokes per round ranking 3<sup>rd</sup> in the field.

**2 Drives 400+ Yards:** Last season, there were seven total drives over 400 yards on the Plantation Course at Kapalua. Justin Thomas (2) and Dustin Johnson (3) were the only two players to hit multiple drives over 400 yards for the week.

**31 Consecutive Greens Hit:** Starting on the 12<sup>th</sup> hole in the opening round, Thomas went on to hit a career best 31 consecutive greens in regulation. This stretch of 31 greens including going a perfect 18 of 18 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round marking the first time in his career where he had hit every green in a round on the PGA TOUR.

Since 2003, the Plantation Course at Kapalua have been one of the easiest greens to hit on TOUR. Last season, the Plantation Course at Kapalua was the only course that the field averaged over 80.0% in Greens in Regulation Percentage. Last season, the field averaged 37' 8" in Proximity to the Hole on all approach shots, ranking as the 10<sup>th</sup> toughest course to get the ball close to the hole.

Last season, the Plantation Course at Kapalua was one of eight courses that the field averaged over 30.0 putts per round. There were 3,928 putts in 128 rounds played (30.69), marking the second highest putts per round of any course on TOUR.

Ryan Armour has made 108 career PGA TOUR starts and is set to make his first appearance at the Sentry Tournament of Champions by way of winning the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship.

#### **Keys to Victory: 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship**

Ryan Armour earned his 1<sup>st</sup> career victory on the PGA TOUR at the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship.

**84.3%** of Ryan's total strokes gained for the week were a result of both his approach the green and putting performances at the CC of Jackson.

Ryan Armour became the 28<sup>th</sup> winner (since 2004) to rank inside the top-3 in SG: Approach-the-Green & Putting en route to victory.

Armour's performance on the back 9 was phenomenal making 273' 10" in total putts and outperformed the field by +7.05 in SG: Putting. Armour's 441' 3" total feet of putts made was the 12<sup>th</sup> most by a winner in the ShotLink era.

**264 Yards from the Tee:** Ryan Armour ranked 74<sup>th</sup> (out of 75 players) for driving distance (all drives) en route to his victory at the Sanderson Farms Championship. His 264.0 average drive from the tee is the shortest ever recorded by a winner at the Sanderson Farms Championship since 2003. Ryan Armour chose to lay-up on 17 of 20 (85%) going for it holes at CC of Jackson, marking the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest lay-up percentage among winners on TOUR since 2003.

## Daniel Berger

Daniel Berger is set to make his second start at the Sentry Tournament of Champions (2017-T14). Berger finished 16<sup>th</sup> in the final FedExCup standings, marking his third consecutive season advancing to the TOUR Championship and is one of nine players to advance to the TOUR Championship in each of the last three seasons.
