#### **ShotLink Keys to Victory for Rod Pampling**

Rod Pampling earned 500 points moving to 4<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings with his 3<sup>rd</sup> career victory in his 342<sup>nd</sup> career start on the PGA TOUR at the 2016 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Pampling opened with a course record tying 60 and became one of four players since 2010 to open a PGA TOUR event with a 60 or better and go onto victory (Steve Stricker-2010 John Deere, Phil Mickelson-2013 WMPO & Justin Thomas-2017 Sony Open (59)).

**83%** of Rod's total strokes gained for the week were a result of his approach & around the green performance at TPC Summerlin.

When missing the greens, Rod Pampling ranked first in SG: Around-the-Green becoming the first player to gain over a stroke per round from around the greens since 2016 PGA Champion Jimmy Walker (+1.226). Pampling outperformed the field by +1.299 strokes in SG: Around-the-Green and salvaged par 68.75% on missed greens.

Last season, the 16<sup>th</sup> hole had the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest GFG-Birdie or Better Percentage of par 5s.

The field went on to make birdie or better on 226 of 300 (75.33%) attempts when going for the green and was a combined 257-under par.

The par 4, 15<sup>th</sup> hole at TPC Summerlin played as the easiest par 4 on TOUR last season at 3.593. Playing at 341 yards, the 15<sup>th</sup> hole ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> for the most birdies or better with 203 and ranked 1<sup>st</sup> in Birdie or Better % from the fairway (45.1%).

Last season all seven of the winners from the first seven PGA TOUR events of the season qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs.

Three of the seven winners from the fall calendar of 2016 (Thomas, Matsuyama and Perez) qualified for the TOUR Championship.

**Defending Champion:** Last season, Rod Pampling finished 74<sup>th</sup> in the final FedExCup standings, marking the fourth Shriners champion since the 2013-14 season to finish inside the top-100 of the standings.

**57.25%:** Just over one out of every two players that earn FedExCup points in the fall events of the PGA TOUR season earn their TOUR card and qualify for the FedExCup Playoffs.

**814 players:** Since 2013-14 season 814 players have earned FedExCup points in the fall events. 466 of 814 (57.25%) players have qualified for the FedExCup Playoffs, and only 102 of 814 (12.53%) have advanced to the TOUR Championship.

Last season, the average age of the final Top-125 of the FedExCup standings was 32.2, (Youngest average age in FedExCup History).

There were 49 players in their 20s in the final Top-125 of the FedExCup standings (Most of any season).

#### **Smylie Kaufman**

Smylie Kaufman (2015 Shriners champion) is set to make his third appearance at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Kaufman finished t-4 at last week's Sanderson Farms Championship, marking his first top-5 finish on the PGA TOUR since the 2017 Wells Fargo Championship (t-5).

At the 2017 Sanderson Farms Championship, Kaufman played all 4 rounds at par or better and made 17 birdies or better en route to a t-4 finish. In his only other start this season (Safeway Open), Kaufman played one round at par or better and made 13 birdies or better en route to a 75<sup>th</sup> place finish.

In the final round, Smylie outperformed himself by four strokes Tee-to-Green, averaged 13 feet closer on approach shots and made birdie 50% of the time compared to his first 3 rounds of the week combined.

Smylie Kaufman averaged 327.6 yards off the tee in Driving Distance, measuring over 20 yards longer than the field average of 305.4 yards.

Last season, Rod Pampling finished 74<sup>th</sup> in the final FedExCup standings, marking his second-best finish in the FedExCup (53<sup>rd</sup> in 2007).

Pampling's 74<sup>th</sup> place finish in the FedExCup standings marked only his fourth career finish inside the top-100 of the standings.

Pampling made his longest putt of the week on the final hole of the 2016 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open, a 32-foot putt to secure the win, marking the ninth longest putt made on the final hole by a winner in the ShotLink era.

In the first three rounds, Pampling lost a total of -1.33 strokes to the field on the greens. However, in the final round Pampling outperformed the field by +2.93 strokes on the greens.

Rod Pampling had a hot putter down the stretch making six putts over 10 feet in the final round compared to just four in the previous three rounds. Since 2008, Pampling's six putts made over 10 feet it the final round is the most putts made from this distance during a final round by a Shriners Hospitals champion.


#### Webb Simpson

Webb Simpson (2013 Shriners Hospitals champion) is set to make his seventh start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. Last season, Simpson finished 17<sup>th</sup> in the final FedExCup standings on the strength of six top-10s and 12 top-25 finishes.

Since 2008, Webb Simpson's 67.73 stroke average at TPC Summerlin is the lowest among players with a minimum of 10 rounds played. Simpson has played 21 of 22 rounds of par or better and is a combined 72-under par at TPC Summerlin in this span.

#### **Graeme McDowell**

Graeme is set to make his 2<sup>nd</sup> start of the 2017-18 PGA TOUR season. Graeme finished 136<sup>th</sup> in the final FedExCup standings last season and missed the FedExCup Playoffs for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in the last 3 seasons. McDowell has yet to finish inside of the top-30 of the final FedExCup standings with his best finish coming in 2012, 42<sup>nd</sup>.

Since the start of the wrap-around season (2013-14), Graeme McDowell has taken advantage of getting off to a quick start. Graeme has recorded one win and four top-5s in seven season opening events since 2013-14 PGA TOUR season.

#### Jimmy Walker

Since the start of the 2013-14 PGA TOUR season, Jimmy Walker has recorded six PGA TOUR wins, 22 top-10s & 47 top-25s. His six victories are the t-5<sup>th</sup> most of any player and his cumulative score of 207-under par is the 37<sup>th</sup> best on TOUR.

Jimmy Walker has ranked inside of the top-20 for Strokes Gained: Approach-the-Green in each of the last two PGA TOUR seasons. Walker has outperformed the TOUR by over a half a stroke per round in each season.

2017 Sanderson Farm Championship winner, Ryan Armour is set to make his fourth start at the Shriners Hospitals for Children Open. In three previous appearances at this event, Armour has made one cut (2007/t-66) and missed the cut in his last two starts at this event (2008 & 2014-15).

Ryan Armour became the 28<sup>th</sup> winner (since 2004) to rank inside the top-3 in SG: Approach-the-Green & Putting en route to victory. Armour's performance on the back 9 was phenomenal making 273' 10" in total putts and outperformed the field by +7.05 in SG: Putting. Armour's 441' 3" total feet of putts made was the 12<sup>th</sup> most by a winner in the ShotLink era.

His 264.0 average drive from the tee is the shortest ever recorded by a winner at the Sanderson Farms Championship since 2003. Ryan Armour chose to lay-up on 17 of 20 (85%) going for it holes at CC of Jackson, marking the 3<sup>rd</sup> highest lay-up percentage among winners on TOUR since 2003.
