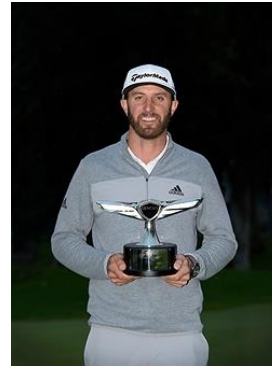

# GENESIS OPEN



### ShotLink Keys to Victory for Dustin Johnson

Dustin Johnson picked up his 13<sup>th</sup> career PGA TOUR victory marking his 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive season with at least one victory (best active streak on TOUR). Johnson moved from 33<sup>rd</sup> to sixth in the FedExCup standings with his win at the 2017 Genesis Open.

77% of Dustin's total strokes gained for the week came from his performance off the tee and on the greens (32% off the tee and 45% on the greens).

**Leading Field Off-the-Tee:** Dustin Johnson led the field for Strokes Gained: Off-the-Tee en route to his victory, marking the 25<sup>th</sup> time he's accomplished this feat on the PGA TOUR since 2008. Only Bubba Watson has led more events Off-the-Tee over this time frame (27 times).

**Only Player Over 300 Yards:** Dustin was the only player in the field to average over 300 yards on all drives for the week. In fact, his 300.6 average driving distance was 22 yards longer than the field average and eight yards longer than the second longest player in the field (Adam Scott 292.4 yards). Johnson is just the fifth player in the ShotLink era to average over 300 yards off the tee (all drives) for a week at Riviera Country Club.

**#1 for Greens in Regulation:** Dustin hit a field leading 77.8% of the greens in regulation for the week marking the fifth time he's led the field for greens in regulation in a PGA TOUR event. Johnson's field leading average of 77.8% was nearly 20% better than the field average for the week (58.6%).

Last season, the greens at Riviera CC ranked as the fifth toughest greens to hit on the PGA TOUR. In fact, the field only hit 58.61% of the greens in regulation.

Last season, players managed to salvage par at Riviera CC 62.71% of the time when missing the green, ranking as the fourth easiest Scrambling course in full field, single course events.

**18.08%:** Last season, players made birdie or better from inside 125 yards 18.08% of the time from this distance, ranking second lowest of any course.

Since 2011, Riviera CC has ranked as the toughest course when putting from three feet in five of the last seven seasons on the PGA TOUR. Since 2008, K.J. Choi has made 99.54% (434 of 436) putts from three feet at this course, marking the best putts made percentage of any player. Defending champion, Dustin Johnson ranks fourth, making 98.33% (386 of 393) putts from this distance at this course.

Since 2004, no other hole has yielded more eagles than the 1st hole at Riviera CC.

384 total eagles have been made on the opening hole at Riviera CC marking the most on any hole on TOUR.

Last season, the 236-yard (scorecard yardage) par 3, fourth hole at Riviera CC played as the third toughest green to hit. 35.14% (149 of 424) of the tee shots on the fourth hole at Riviera CC ended on the green. In 2017, Tyron Van Aswegen hit the green on the fourth hole in all four rounds of the Genesis Open, marking the only player to hit this green in regulation in every round.

## Broadcast Window Notes

### 2018 Genesis Open *(featured groups)*

#### Tiger Woods

Tiger Woods is set to make his second start of the 2017-18 PGA TOUR season and 12<sup>th</sup> at the Genesis Open. Tiger has 79 career PGA TOUR victories at 25 different events on TOUR. However, the Genesis Open is one of only 15 events on TOUR where Tiger has yet to claim victory. Tiger has recorded 14 victories in the state of California in his PGA TOUR career.

After one event this season, Tiger Woods enters this week ranked 175<sup>th</sup> in the FedExCup standings. Two-time FedExCup Champion, Tiger Woods has ranked first in the FedExCup standings a record of 85 total weeks. His 85 weeks is 37 more weeks than the next best player Jimmy Walker with 48.

Since 1997, Tiger Woods is **57-under par** at the Genesis Open, t-3<sup>rd</sup> best of any player. Tiger has the best score in relation to par (-57) among the 658 players with less than 10 starts at this event in this span.

Dustin Johnson & Justin Thomas arguably have been in contention more than any other player on TOUR. Since the start of the 2016 FedExCup Playoffs, Dustin & Justin have been first or second on the leaderboard a combined 49 times after any stroke play round on the PGA TOUR.

### Dustin Johnson

Defending Genesis Open Champion, Dustin Johnson is set to make his 11<sup>th</sup> start at this event and currently ranks third in the FedExCup standings. No one has accumulated more FedExCup points at the Genesis Open than Dustin Johnson. Dustin has totaled 1,522 FEC points since 2009 at this event recording seven top-10 finishes. Dustin has qualified for the TOUR Championship more than any other player on TOUR since 2007. Dustin is in great position this season currently ranked seventh in the FedExCup standings.

Dustin Johnson's SG: Off-the-Tee performance this season has been solid, outperforming the TOUR by +1.884 strokes. His +1.884 SG: Off-the-Tee is over half a stroke better than the next best player Branden Grace who gains +1.254 strokes per round off the tee.

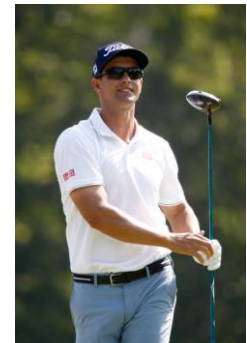

This season, Jordan Spieth has been dialed in on his approach the green performance, averaging 7' 3" closer on approach shots from 150 to 175 yards, ranking third on TOUR.
