ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jason Dufner

Jason Dufner earned his fifth PGA TOUR victory in his 278th start on TOUR at the 2017 the Memorial Tournament. Dufner moved from 56th to 13th in the FedExCup standings, ranking inside the top 30 for the first-time last season. Jason Dufner became the second player from the state of Ohio to win the Memorial Tournament (Jack Nicklaus).

Jason Dufner became the third winner last season to lead the field in SG: Approach-the-Green, outperforming the field by +2.671 strokes per round on approach shots.

After setting the 36-hole scoring record of 130 (65-65) strokes at the Memorial Tournament. Jason Dufner saw a five-stroke lead evaporate after a third-round, 77. His 77 was the highest third round score by a PGA TOUR winner in a non-major since Kenny Knox posted 80 in his third round and went on to win the 1986 Honda Classic.

Last season, Charley Hoffman led the Memorial Tournament field in Scrambling, managing to salvage par 78.79% when missing the green (26 of 33).

Jason Day

Jason Day is set to make his 10th start at the Memorial Tournament. Day currently ranks third in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two wins (Farmers Insurance Open & Wells Fargo) and eight top-25 finishes. This season, Day has spent 19 of 28 weeks inside the top 30 of the standings compared to only four of 43 weeks inside the top 30 last season.

Dustin Johnson

Dustin Johnson is set to make his 11th start at the Memorial Tournament. Dustin currently ranks ninth in the FedExCup standings on the strength of one win (Sentry TOC), four other top 10s and eight top-25 finishes. Since 2009, Dustin Johnson has ranked inside the top 30 entering week #29 in each season, qualifying for the TOUR Championship in all nine seasons. Since the start of the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season, Dustin Johnson has earned 6,395 FedExCup season points, 317 more than the next player (Justin Thomas).

Rory Mcllroy

2016 FedExCup champion Rory Mcllroy is set to make his seventh start at the Memorial Tournament and 10th start this season. Mcllroy currently ranks 36th in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two top 10s (including win at Arnold Palmer Invitational) and four top-25 finishes. This season, five players have moved over 125 positions in the FedExCup standings in a single week. Rory Mcllroy is the biggest mover moving 154 positions with his Arnold Palmer Invitational victory back in March.
