Extended forecast – Weak high pressure will provide partly cloudy skies and less humid conditions on Saturday with highs around 80 degrees. This front will slide east by Sunday evening with clearing skies returning. Partly cloudy, breezy and cooler temperatures can be expected on Monday.
