

# 2018 THE NORTHERN TRUST Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes

THE NORTHERN TRUST serves as the start of the FedExCup Playoffs - the entire season has built to this fourtournament stretch. There is more on the line than just a victory at THE NORTHERN TRUST - players in the top half of the 125 will be looking to move up, working towards the coveted top-five position heading to the TOUR Championship; players near the 100<sup>th</sup> position need enough points to advance to the Dell Technologies Championship (top-100). The top 125 players on the FedExCup points list qualify for THE NORTHERN TRUST.

## Potential #1 Scenario's at THE NORTHERN TRUST

**58 Players Can Move to #1:** 58 players in the field are currently within 2,000 points of the #1 ranked Dustin Johnson (last season 38 players were within 2,000 points of Hideki Matsuyama) and can in turn potentially move to #1 with a victory this week. Jimmy Walker is the last player (61<sup>st</sup> position) who could possibly take over the #1 position. The 125<sup>th</sup> position currently owned by Seamus Power is currently 2,340 points behind first place and could move as high as 3<sup>rd</sup> with a victory.

## Moving Week at THE NORTHERN TRUST

This is the first week where point values are quadrupled (4x their Regular Season value). Prior to this week event winners would receive 500 points (regular events) where now they will receive 2,000 points. THE NORTHERN TRUST has traditionally served as the catalyst event to make substantial moves in the FedExCup standings.

Entering the 2009 THE NORTHERN TRUST, **Heath Slocum** ranked 124<sup>th</sup> in the standings. His victory vaulted him 121 spots to 3<sup>rd</sup> and secured a spot at the TOUR Championship (largest move in the 11-year history of the FedExCup Playoffs).

## Largest Moves in any FedExCup Playoff Event (2009-2016)

Last Season, **Bubba Watson** was the biggest mover in any event of the 2017 FedExCup Playoffs moving from 113<sup>th</sup> to 72<sup>nd</sup> (41 positions) at THE NORTHERN TRUST.

In 2016, **Sean O'Hair** moved from 108<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> with his t-2 finish at THE ORTHERN TRUST. O'Hair moved up 93 spots ranking as the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest move in any event in FedExCup Playoff history.

## 12th Year Qualifying for FedExCup

**Playoffs:** 10 of the top 125 players entering this week have qualified for all 12 seasons of the FedExCup Playoffs. Four of the 10 players enter THE NORTHERN TRUST ranked inside the top-30 of the FedExCup standings.

Since 2009, In the last three seasons 40 or more players in their 20s have qualified for the FedExCup playoffs. Last season, 49 players were in their 20s recording the greatest number of players in their 20s since 2009.

At 22 years old, Aaron Wise is the youngest player to make the 2018 FedExCup Playoffs.

This season. Justin Rose ranks sixth in SG: Putting compared to 123<sup>rd</sup> in this category last season. Rose is the only player on TOUR that has made over 80% of their attempts from four to eight feet. From this distance, Rose has made a TOUR leading 80.15% of his attempts (109 of 136).

Bubba Watson has a 69.87 stroke average at THE NORTHERN TRUST, marking his best scoring average in the four FedExCup Playoffs events. Since 2007, Bubba Watson has recorded 33 of 38 rounds (86.8%) par or better at THE NORTHERN TRUST, marking the most rounds of any player.

This season, Jason Day leads the TOUR in Strokes Gained: Putting. Day is outperforming the TOUR by +0.976 strokes per round on the greens. Day outperforms the Field in the FedExCup Playoffs by +0.738 strokes per round in SG: Putting, marking the second-best performance (min 40 rds). From five to 10 feet, Jason Day ranks second-all time in the Playoffs, converting 365 of 557 putts from this distance (65.53%). Jason Day is one of two players (Jim Furyk) that are over 200-under par in their FedExCup Playoffs career.
