- DeChambeau holds the largest 54-hole lead at THE NORTHERN TRUST in the FedExCup era
- Keegan Bradley hit all 18 greens in regulation for the first time in his career
- Tiger Woods recorded his first bogey-free round since 2015

- Career-best nine birdies (previous: 8/five previous instances; most recent: R2/2018 the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide)
- Holds the largest 54-hole lead at THE NORTHERN TRUST in the FedExCup era (previous: 3/twice; most recent: Jordan Spieth/2017)
- 54-hole leaders by margins of four strokes or more during the 2017-18 season are 5-for-7 converting the lead into victory (Dustin Johnson/World Golf Championships-HSBC Champions, Paul Casey/Travelers Championship did not win)

## Keegan Bradley (2<sup>nd</sup>)

- Tied Ridgewood Country Club course record (62/Hunter Mahan/2008/R1)
- Hit all 18 greens in regulation for the first time in his career (17/18 on 10 previous occasions)
- Low 18-hole score since 2013 AT&T Byron Nelson (60/R1)
- Tied season-low front-nine score (31/twice; most recent: R4/RBC Canadian Open)
- Tied season-low back-nine score (31/R1/A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier)

### Cameron Smith (T3)

- Projected to move from No. 53 to No. 15 in the FedExCup
- Leads the field in scrambling through 54 holes (12/14)
- Four top-fives in 2017-18 (3<sup>rd</sup>/THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES, T5/CIMB Classic, T5/World Golf Championships-Dell Technologies Match Play, T5/Masters Tournament)
- Has recorded three under-par scores through three rounds after having four such scores in his last 20 rounds entering the week

### Tony Finau (T3)

- Projected to move from No. 12 to No. 5 in the FedExCup
- Holds highest FedExCup position among players without a win in 2017-18
- Leads the field in Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green (8.405) and Strokes Gained: Around-the-Green (5.477)
- Three previous starts at THE NORTHERN TRUST (12<sup>th</sup>/2016 best previous result)
- Qualified for the TOUR Championship for the first time in 2017 (final standing: 19<sup>th</sup>)

## Tiger Woods (T49)

- Bogey-free 68
- First bogey-free round since a fourth-round 67 at the 2015 A Military Tribute at The Greenbrier (68 rounds ago)
- 76<sup>th</sup> in Strokes Gained: Putting through 54 holes (-3.952)

#### Miscellaneous notes

- The four players in the final two groups were a combined 3-over-par (average of 71.750; field average in round three: 69.825)
- Scores: Adam Scott 70, Brooks Koepka 72, Dustin Johnson 72, Jamie Lovemark 73

#### FedExCup and THE NORTHERN TRUST

- THE NORTHERN TRUST is the opening event of the FedExCup Playoffs for the 12th consecutive season since the FedExCup Playoffs were introduced in 2007.
- Each playoff event offers 2,000 FedExCup points to the winner.
- The top-125 players on the final PGA TOUR Season FedExCup points list (following the Wyndham Championship) qualified for THE NORTHERN TRUST.
