Five Things To Know

- Si Woo Kim's 5-under 67 is the lowest first-round score by a defending champion at THE PLAYERS
- Most eagles (23) in a round at THE PLAYERS
- Six players tied for lead is second-most in THE PLAYERS history (7/1978) and most since move to TPC Sawgrass in 1982
- Dustin Johnson's 6-under 66 is his lowest score and first bogey-free round in 31 career rounds at THE PLAYERS
- Jordan Spieth's 75 ties his highest score at TPC Sawgrass; has missed the cut in each of the last three seasons

- Made 139' 2" of putts in R1, nearly double his 2017-18 average of 76' 3"
- Best 2017-18 results: T4/Sony Open in Hawaii, T5/The Honda Classic, T5/RBC Heritage

Alex Noren (T1)

- First season as a PGA TOUR member (No. 22 in FedExCup)
- T10/2017 in THE PLAYERS debut
- Three top-three results in 10 starts in 2017-18
- Only one of the six players tied for the lead without a PGA TOUR victory
- Best PGA TOUR finishes (44 career starts): P2/2018 Farmers Insurance Open, 3rd/2018 The Honda Classic, 3rd/2018 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play

Patrick Cantlay (T1)

- T22/2017 in THE PLAYERS debut
- Wins: 1 (2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children Open)
- 16th in the FedExCup standings
- Four top-10s in 11 starts in 2017-18
- T7 in each of last two starts (RBC Heritage, Zurich Classic of New Orleans)

Steve Stricker (T7)

- Playing in his 21st PLAYERS (best result: T6/1999)
- First-round 67 ties career low round at TPC Sawgrass (R2/2011)

Hole 12 modifications:

- Extend fairway bunker improve definition of left edge of approach from tee, and catch balls landing left and short
- Reduce width of the fairway bunker and widen fairway just short of approach improve visual to right side of approach from tee
- Raise left edge of approach and Lower right edge of approach so that tee shots to not feed as severely towards the water
- Double the width of the rough strip along bulkhead and make half of it primary rough height
