Hole 12 modifications:

- Extend fairway bunker - improve definition of left edge of approach from tee, and catch balls landing left and short
- Reduce width of the fairway bunker and widen fairway just short of approach - improve visual to right side of approach from tee
- Raise left edge of approach and Lower right edge of approach so that tee shots to not feed as severely towards the water
- Double the width of the rough strip along bulkhead and make half of it primary rough height
