## Dustin Johnson (T17)

- Loses No. 1 ranking in OWGR
- Only three players have had a stretch longer as No. 1 (64 weeks); Greg Norman (96), Nick Faldo (81), Tiger Woods (281)


## Justin Rose (T23)

- Made six consecutive birdies (holes 9-14) to tie THE PLAYERS record ( $10^{\text {th }}$ instance; most recent: Webb Simpson/2018/R2, holes 11-16)


## Kiradech Aphibarnrat (T30)

- Qualifies for Special Temporary Membership on PGA TOUR and has 60 days to accept
- Has 290 non-member FedExCup points in the 2017-18 season, surpassing the 269 points required
- Special Temporary Membership allows players to accept unlimited sponsor invitations for the remainder of the season as they attempt to secure their PGA TOUR card for the following season

Si Woo Kim finished T63 in his title defense. The last PLAYERS defending champion to finish in the top 10 was Adam Scott in 2005 (T8), four strokes behind Fred Funk.

Hole 12 modifications:

- Extend fairway bunker - improve definition of left edge of approach from tee, and catch balls landing left and short
- Reduce width of the fairway bunker and widen fairway just short of approach - improve visual to right side of approach from tee
- Raise left edge of approach and lower right edge of approach so that tee shots do not feed as severely towards the water
- Double the width of the rough strip along bulkhead and make half of it primary rough height
