Today – A developing area of low pressure over the Gulf of Mexico will slowly push moisture northward out of S. Florida today. A mix of sun and clouds can be expected with skies becoming cloudy by the evening hours. There is a slight chance for a shower by evening, but the bulk of the precipitation should hold off until after midnight tonight.

Extended forecast – Showers and isolated t-storms will increase in coverage late Sunday night into Monday morning as a weak area of low pressure develops and slowly moves northward in the Gulf of Mexico. Showers and thunderstorms will likely continue for most of the day before lifting north of the area. Rainfall could be heavy at times with 1-1.5" of rainfall possible. Scattered showers and t-storms will continue on Tuesday as deep tropical moisture remains of the region.
