ShotLink Keys to Victory for Jordan Spieth

Jordan Spieth moved from sixth to fourth in the FedExCup standings, ranking inside the top five in the standings for the 10th week last season. Spieth recorded his 10th career PGA TOUR title in his 120th start at the age of 23 years, 10 months, 29 days. Spieth joined Tiger Woods as the only players in the modern era with 10 PGA TOUR wins by the age of 24. Woods had 15 before he turned 24.

Spieth became the third wire-to-wire winner* (no ties) at the Travelers Championship (Gene Littler (1959) and Tim Norris (1982)), and first to do so at TPC River Highlands

Jordan Spieth ranked 56th in SG: Off-the-Tee, losing -0.255 strokes per round. This marked only the fourth-time last season where a player has gone onto win when losing strokes off the tee. In fact, Jordan lost strokes off the tee en route to winning the 2017 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am.

Jordan Spieth averaged nearly 15 feet closer on approach shots from the rough averaging 27' 0" to the hole. Spieth's play from around the green was over a stroke and a half better than the field in strokes gained

Jordan's play from around the green was the best of any winner last season for SG: Around-the-Green (4 measured rounds where ShotLink was used). His average of +1.506 was the best by a winner in this category since James Hahn won the 2015 Genesis Open (+1.559).

Jordan Spieth

Defending champion Jordan Spieth is set to make his second appearance at the Travelers Championship. Spieth's win at the Travelers Championship last season marked his first PGA TOUR victory when making his tournament debut. Jordan Spieth currently ranks 38th in the FedExCup standings and is one of 18 players that currently rank outside the top 30 that were inside the top 30 in the standings at this point last season.

Marc Leishman outperformed the field by +3.147 strokes from tee to green en route to victory in 2012, marking the best Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green performance by a winner at this event since 2004.

For the week, 64% of his total strokes gained came from his approach-the-green performance (+2.025 strokes per round).

2016 winner of the Travelers Championship Russell Knox is set to make his seventh start at this event. Knox is coming off a T12 finish at the U.S. Open marking his eighth top-25 finish this season. Russell currently ranks 67th in the FedExCup standings.

Thomas currently ranks second in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two wins (THE CJ CUP @ NINE BRIDGES and The Honda Classic) and is one of only two players in the field this week that can reclaim the #1 position in the FedExCup Standings with a win (Jason Day, 4th).

Brooks Koepka is coming off his second Major Championship victory at the U.S. Open. Koepka is the first player to go back-to-back at the U.S. Open since Curtis Strange in 1988 & 1989. Koepka earned 600 FedExCup standings moving from 46th to 13th in the standings.

Jason Day is set to make his fourth start at the Travelers Championship. Day currently ranks fourth in the FedExCup standings on the strength of two wins and four top-10 finishes this season. Day is coming off a missed cut at last week's U.S. Open posting rounds of 79-73.

Last week, Jason Day posted his highest opening two rounds this season (76.0), missing the cut at the U.S. Open. In his three starts at the Travelers Championship, Day's opening rounds have progressively been on a decline since his hot start at TPC River Highlands in 2008.

Jason Day holds the record for best SG: Putting in a season on TOUR. Since the inception of Strokes Gained: Putting in 2004, Jason Day holds the single season best Strokes Gained: Putting performance. This season, Day has been solid ranking first in SG: Putting gaining +1.086 strokes per round on the greens.
