


2018 Zurich Classic of New Orleans Broadcast Window & Pre-Tournament Notes





Defending Champions Jonas Blixt & Cameron Smith

Defending Zurich Classic of New Orleans champions, Jonas Blixt and Cameron Smith entered the 2017 Zurich Classic outside the top 50 in the FedExCup standings and moved inside the top 40 in the standings with their win. Jonas Blixt moved 113 positions in the standings from 153rd to 40th and Cameron Smith moved 47 positions, from 67th to 20th, marking the two biggest moves in the FedExCup standings at the 2017 Zurich Classic of New Orleans.

2017 FedExCup champion, Justin Thomas has ranked #1 in the FedExCup standings in each of the last nine consecutive weeks on TOUR, surpassing Patton Kizzire for the most weeks ranked #1 in the standings this season.

This season, there have been seven first-time winners on TOUR (8 wins). Four of the seven first-time winners are currently ranked inside the top 30 of the FedExCup standings (Kizzire, Landry, Cantlay and Cook).

Patton Kizzire (2nd) and Andrew Landry (9th) are the only two first-time winners ranked inside the top 10 of the FedExCup standings.

Currently ranked 26th and 124th in the FedExCup standings, Ian Poulter and Graeme McDowell are seeking to make it to the TOUR Championship for the first time in the FedExCup era.

Poulter and McDowell have combined for 15 appearances in the FedExCup Playoffs, making it to the BMW Championship in 11 of those 15 seasons.

Team Format 2018 Zurich Classic of New Orleans

- The 72-hole stroke play format will feature Four-Ball (best ball) during the first and third rounds and Foursomes (alternate shot) during the second and fourth rounds. The starting field will consist of 80 teams (160 players). Each of the top available players from the PGA TOUR Priority Rankings who commits to the tournament will choose his partner, who in turn must have PGA TOUR status unless he is chosen as a tournament sponsor exemption.
- Following the conclusion of the second round, there will be a cut to the low 35 teams and ties at the 35th position. In case of a tie after 72 holes, there will be a sudden-death playoff using the Foursomes format for the first extra hole, Four-ball for the second extra hole and the alternating formats, thereafter, on a set rotation of holes.
- The Zurich Classic of New Orleans will continue to award FedExCup points and official
 money and will count as an official victory for the members of the winning team. As such,
 both players will receive a two-year winner's exemption and an eligibility into Invitational
 fields, including the Sentry Tournament of Champions and THE PLAYERS Championship.
- FedExCup points and prize money will be awarded to teams making the cut based on
 combining every two positions from the distribution table for a standard TOUR event, with
 each team member receiving an equal share. For instance, the winning team will evenly split
 first and second place FedExCup points (500 for first and 300 for second for 800 total
 points, or 400 for each player). Official prize money will be distributed in the same manner.

Standout Stats

Bud Cauley (teamed with Justin Thomas this week) is the second biggest improver in Strokes Gained: Putting from last season to this season. Cauley has improved from ranking 154th last season to 17th this season marking a 137-position improvement in this category.

In the 2015-16 PGA TOUR season, Jason Day outperformed the TOUR by +1.130 strokes per round on the greens, marking the best Strokes Gained: Putting performance in a single season by any player. This season, Jason Day has an opportunity to break his own record in this category. Day currently leads the TOUR in Strokes Gained: Putting, outperforming the TOUR by +1.386 strokes per round on the greens.

28 Consecutive Cuts Made: Since the 2017 Houston Open, Matt Kuchar has made 28 consecutive cuts on the PGA TOUR, marking the longest active cuts made streak of any player. In this time frame, Matt Kuchar has recorded 11 top 10s (39.3%) and has earned 2,374 FedExCup points.
