

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW

SCOTT McCARRON (-15)

Q. Scott, a flawless 64, beautiful round of golf today to win the American Family Championship. What was the thing that was going for you the best today?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, you know, all week I drove the ball really well and I was hitting a lot of good iron shots, I hit a lot of greens. I think I made one bogey all week and that was early on on Friday. Just missed a short putt, one of the par 3s and made bogey. Other than that, I really didn't have any other opportunities to make bogeys. I just kept putting myself in play, putting it fairly close and I finally putted better this week.

Q. I was going to ask you, your putter, the airlines broke your putter from last year?

SCOTT McCARRON: They did.

Q. You putted beautifully last year, finished second on Tour, so you had to go to a new putter. What's the adjustment for that been like? Obviously you haven't putted as well you wanted to, I would imagine?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, I've been trying all kinds of different putters. I have about four or five of these at home. TaylorMade makes them special for me, it's a center post shaft. But I didn't have one that was quite right and so it took me, you know, a good month, month and a half, two months to finally get the weighting right, get everything right and find the right putter that felt right because they all feel a little different, as you know. I finally kind of got it figured out here really over the last week when I was at home.

Q. With the major season coming up, you've got three more coming up and you're defending in the SENIOR PLAYERS Constellation -- PLAYERS Championship, excuse me. How do you feel about your game right now and what are the things you possibly need to work on going into these three tournaments?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, obviously my game's pretty good, just won this week, so I'm pretty happy the way I'm hitting it. I started putting better this week. I've got to work on my wedge game, I've got to wedge it closer. I have a lot of wedges out here and I'm trying to take a little bit of spin off because I'm a little bit steep and I get a lot of spin. So this week was a challenge with them being a little soft with all the rain they had, but it's a work in progress so I'm working every week on that.
