**Q. Tom, just talk a little bit about that one you made on 18 to make the playoff.**

**TOM LEHMAN:** Well, it was about a four-foot putt, maybe four and a half just inside the right edge putt and I hit a really solid putt. I've got to say, I have a great partner. When you play with a partner like Bernhard Langer, it makes the game so much easier, full of confidence with everything that we do, and knowing you can trust he's going to always about there so it makes putts like that easier.

**Q. Bernhard, we were over there on 16 when you made the putt and you moved into a tie, but then right behind you Kirk made a putt. Talk a little bit about your run toward the end, you made a little run at the end?**

**BERNHARD LANGER:** Yeah, we were always a couple behind so we figured we had to finish very strong to hopefully get a W out of this and we did. We made a few birdies coming home between us, which put us in a good position to get into the playoff, and we hit a couple of great shots here, but it was a fantastic bunker shot from Kirk and we missed our putts.

**Q. I was going to say, how deflating is it when you see that happen?**

**TOM LEHMAN:** Well, you kind of learn to expect it. These guys out here are so good and Kirk Triplett is a magician around the greens. The odds of making that shot are probably not good, but you certainly expect him to hit a great shot and he did and it went in. I kind of felt like we both hit pretty good putts, misread them, both of them. I hit mine probably too hard and Bernhard's too soft, but you have to hand it to the guys who hit the shot when they have to hit it.
