

BART BRYANT (-10)

Q. Best round in quite a while for you?

BART BRYANT: Yeah, yeah. Last year was not a good year. Golf-wise it was not good, so honestly, it's the first good round I've played in quite a long time so it felt good to do that for a change.

Q. Has it been a process of getting back to golf after what last year --

BART BRYANT: It has, yeah. I think I feel a little more settled right now, it's a little more about golf. Last year it wasn't about golf much at all, even towards the end of the year, it was about other things. But I felt more settled, I've been able to get a little bit more practice in in the offseason. I'm still not exactly sure where my game is, to be honest with, you but I'm starting to see some good stuff, so hopefully that's going to be an indication of what's to come.

Q. What was going for you today?

BART BRYANT: Honestly, it was solid. I really only hit one bad shot today, the second shot on 17, but other than that I put ball where I wanted it to be. Made a couple of nice putts, not anything abnormal but just did what I was supposed to do and really managed my game well, so it's a good sign.

Q. When you make a double eagle on a hole, do you have to think about it every time you play that hole?

BART BRYANT: Oh, every time I step on 18 tee everybody reminds me of it. We had a little conversation going on there on 18 tee while we were waiting to hit our tee shots. Pretty funny. But it's a good memory, and every time I stand on that fairway, I had a 6-iron today, which I think I made it with a 5 or something, I was looking at it going, you know, I think this could be made. Of course, you know, the odds of that ever happening again are slim and none, but at least the thought was there, so that's good.

Q. Well, the fact that you were right there that year shows you that you can be in contention to say the least on this course. Do you feel good about your chances here?

BART BRYANT: I'll have to shoot another low round tomorrow. Honestly, I played good the last 27 holes. I shot 37 my first nine, which that normally knocks you out of a tournament, it's pretty difficult to come back. Luckily, I had a little bit of a hot streak. But for

me to win tomorrow I have to go low. I mean guys will, I'm sure. I'll probably be in the top-5 or 6. Somebody in there or somebody's going to go out and shoot 7 or 8 under tomorrow just like I did today. So it's going to take another really low round, but at least I'm in a position where if I were to shoot a low round, I would have a chance, and that's good. I haven't been there in a while, so it's good.
