Extended forecast – A few lingering showers and storms are expected this evening, followed by clearing skies. On Sunday, just enough moisture and instability will linger over northeastern IL to allow a few isolated showers and storms to develop during the afternoon. A lake breeze is expected to develop in the afternoon, which could become the focus for storm development. It is a bit unclear the exact location of storms, but it appears that areas west of the Chicago area have the highest threat.
