SCOTT McCARRON (-13)



Q. Scott, can you just talk us through your day? Another good one.

SCOTT McCARRON: Yeah, good solid day, no bogeys today. I drove the ball pretty well, hit a lot of fairways, gave myself a lot of opportunities, and then hit it close on 17 and 18. Always nice to be able to finish the round hitting it close.

I felt very good out there playing with one of my good friends, Glen Day. We had a good day and I made some nice putts, and it was nice to have a good round. It was a good round today.

Q. Obviously a long way to go, but you continue to put yourself where you need to be, I guess, right?

SCOTT McCARRON: Yeah, that's all we can do. It's Friday, only the second round, but I've got to put myself in position. You can't win the tournament today, but you can't lose it -- but you sure can lose it today. So I'm in a good position to go into the weekend and just got to keep the pedal down all weekend.

Q. How about your golf game right now, do you feel like it's really coming along at the right time?

SCOTT McCARRON: Yeah, I feel pretty comfortable out there right now. You know, I haven't played as well over the last month and a half as I would like to. Put myself in position, didn't get it done on Sunday. But I've been really working a lot, a lot of good stuff, and working hard with my teacher, E.A. Tischler. And I'm ready for the season to end, but right now I'm still excited to play the next two days.

Q. You told us yesterday pressure's just kind of what you make of it, but Saturday, Sunday coming up, do you start to at least think about what's ahead of you possibly?

SCOTT McCARRON: Well, I'm in an interesting position because I can still win and not win the Schwab Cup. If I win and Langer finishes third or fourth by himself, he wins the Schwab Cup. I can't be worrying about that too much. I've got to go out there tomorrow and hit the first fairway and try to birdie the first hole and take it from there. Pressure's what you put on it. Obviously I would like to win the Schwab Cup, that was my goal at the start of the year. It's a little bit out of my control, but the only way I can have any possibility is to win this golf tournament.
