TIM PETROVIC (-17)

Q. Tim, three solid rounds under your belt right now, well positioned for tomorrow. Game plan going into the final round?

TIM PETROVIC: Same thing here, Petro golf. Hit about half the fairways. Seems to get me focused more once I get off the fairway. I get into the fairway and I'm like, okay, what do we do now?

Seriously, I rolled it today. I felt really good over the putter today kind of like I did the first day. Started out better today than I did yesterday and didn't have to kind of battle my way, just tried to stay consistent through the round. Hit a few squirrely shots, which, you know, that's golf.

Q. Does it matter going into tomorrow's round if you're in the last group or second-to-last group?

TIM PETROVIC: I kind of liked being in the second-to-last group today for some reason, I don't know why. I did enjoy playing with Paul yesterday, so either way's good for me.

Q. So is that because you're a little bit more comfortable, less pressure maybe?

TIM PETROVIC: I would rather be in the lead, of course, or two or three ahead, but I don't mind chasing, either. Either way's good. Keep everything -- keep all the guys in front of me, but I don't mind being in the last group.
