TIM PETROVIC (-18)

Q. Four consistent rounds. How are you feeling about the finish that you had?

TIM PETROVIC: Well, yeah, just today really wasn't my best putting day, really didn't get the feel of the greens early. Of course I chipped in on the first hole for eagle. It kind of shocked me. I was like, what just happened, did we just chip in? But it was more like a pitch-in, it was a real tough shot.

Just a couple mental errors today. Drove it about the same, hit about half the fairways. Came down to knocking a few putts in here and there.

Q. So are you happy with how you finished this season?

TIM PETROVIC: Yeah, yeah, I gave it a run. We gave it a run this week and I'm just glad this is, as we said, the last day of school today.

Q. And looking forward to next year, what will you take kind of positives and negatives from this season on?

TIM PETROVIC: All positives. If we end up finishing second here, five seconds, I guess you could say three seconds in majors, that's pretty good. Hopefully we'll work and I think the victory will eventually come, but keep doing what we're doing and it will happen.
