- All three days will be nationally televised on Golf Channel with a combined \$1.25 million in prize money at stake and two leaderboards: one for PGA TOUR Champions and LPGA pros (\$750,000); and one for the 52 celebrities (\$500,000).
- The Diamond Resorts Invitational<sup>™</sup> (<u>DRIGolf.com</u>) is a 54-hole, modified Stableford point system competition. Groups will include one professional plus two celebrities, playing individually from the same tees all three days.
