#### Scott Parel, 34 points

- Despite battling flu-like symptoms, Parel tallied nine birdies, two bogeys and seven pars, which resulted in 34 points in the modified stableford format.
- In 2017, Parel ranked third on Tour in total birdies made (330) and birdies per round (4.52).
- The 2018 season will be his second as a fully-exempt member on PGA TOUR Champions. He was co-medalist at Q-School in 2016 to earn status for the 2017 season, and last year he tallied six top-10s and finished 21st in the final Charles Schwab Cup standings to remain fully exempt for 2018. His best finish last year was a tie for second at the Regions Tradition.

#### Notes - Professional Field

- Defending champion **Woody Austin** tallied 24 points and is T14.
- Next week, six players in the field will travel from Orlando to Hawaii for the season-opening Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai: Austin, Mark Calcavecchia (T22, 20 points), Joe Durant (T6, 28 points), Jeff Maggert (T8, 26 points), Jeff Sluman (T15, 23 points) and Duffy Waldorf (12th, 25 points).
- Golf Channel commentator **Charlie Rymer** tallied 21 points and is T19. He turned 50 on December 18, 2017, and he plans on making his PGA TOUR Champions debut at the Boca Raton Championship in February.
- **Brooke Henderson** carded five birdies and 13 pars en route to 28 points and a T6 position through 18 holes. **Brittany Lincicome** (14 points), **Gerina Piller** (13 points) and **Brittany Lang** (12 points) are the other three LPGA players in the field.

### Notes - Celebrity Field

- **Mardy Fish**, the 2016 champion of this event, totaled 26 points after making five birdies, two bogeys and 11 pars. Last year, he finished T2 with 67 total points. Fish is a six-time winner on the ATP Tour.
- Defending champion **Mark Mulder** opened with 21 points and is T3. He is the three-time defending champion of the American Century Celebrity Golf Championship, and last year he won this event with 77 total points.
- PGA TOUR Champions Ambassador Alfonso Ribeiro tallied 12 points and is 18th out of 52 celebrities.
