Q. I saw you shake his hand right when he made his putt. What was it like battling out there?

Q. And then can you give some final thoughts on the tournament?

MICHAEL BRADLEY: Oh, it's always great. I love coming back here. The people are great, it's a fun little golf course, they treat you well. It goes back to when we used to play the Tour event here, so we've got a lot of memories, the older guys playing here. Yeah, love coming back here.
