Final-Round Notes Sunday, August 19, 2018

Course Setup: Par 72 / 6,994 yards (R3 average: 70.093, Cumulative: 70.952) Weather: Mostly cloudy with a high in the low 70s. Light wind from the NE.

Note: Lift, clean and place was in effect.

Summary: Bart Bryant made a 40-foot birdie putt on the 18th hole to secure a one-shot victory over Michael Bradley at the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open. Bryant became the first repeat winner in tournament history (2013, 2018), and both of his wins on PGA TOUR Champions have come at this event.

Bart Bryant, 68-67-65 – 200 (-16)

- Bryant was T2 and two shots behind Michael Bradley at the start of the final round. He took his first solo lead when he birdied No. 11 to get to 15-under.
- Leading by one over Bradley on No. 18, Bryant hit his approach to 40 feet while Bradley had a six-foot birdie putt to potentially force a playoff. Bryant put his lead out of reach, as he made the long birdie putt and secured his second win at En-Joie Golf Club.
- Bryant also won the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open in 2013, and he becomes the tournament's first repeat winner.
- Bryant was bogey-free over his last 29 holes, and the only bogey he made was on the par-3 7th hole on Saturday.
- He was 9-under on the par 4s this week, the best in the field. On the season, he ranks No. 5 on Tour in par 4 scoring (28-under).
- This was the third time Bryant played in Sunday's final group this season, and the first time he emerged with the victory. His previous finishes were T24 at the Boca Raton Championship and T6 at the Constellation SENIOR PLAYERS Championship.
- This was Bryant's third top-10 of the season and he improved to 15th in the Charles Schwab Cup.

Michael Bradley, 65-68-68 – 201 (-15)

- Bradley led by two at the start of the final round, and he last held the lead on the 14th hole. He bogeyed the par-4 15th, just his second bogey of the week, and fell one shot behind Bryant.
- Trailing by one on No. 18, Bradley hit a pitching wedge from 137 yards to six feet. He made the birdie putt, but it came after Bryant holed his tournament-winning 40-footer.
- He was the seventh alternate and earned entry when Bill Glasson withdrew.
- As the highest top-10 finisher that wasn't already exempt for the next co-sponsored event, Bradley earned entry into next week's Boeing Classic.
- The runner-up finish is the best of his PGA TOUR Champions career, and it was his third top-10. He improved to No. 36 in the Charles Schwab Cup.

Other Notes

- Playing in the final threesome with Bryant and Bradley, **Marco Dawson** birdied Nos. 1 and 3 to tie Bradley atop the leaderboard at 11-under. He was 2-under over the last 15 holes and finished T3 at 13-under. It was his second top-10 in his last three starts, as he finished T6 at The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex.
- In his second career start on PGA TOUR Champions, **Tom Gillis** carded a final-round 67 and finished T3 at 13-under. He also finished T3 in his debut at the 3M Championship, and he has shot 67 in five of his first six rounds on Tour.
- **Paul Goydos** closed with a 7-under 65, his best score in 15 rounds at the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open, and he finished T5 at 12-under. It was his third top-five at this tournament, as he won in 2016 and was runner-up in 2015.
- Coming off a win at the 3M Championship, **Kenny Perry** shot a final-round 67 and finished T5 at 12-under.
- Mark Calcavecchia was part of the three-way tie for fifth and posted his fifth top-10 of the season.
- Defending champion **Scott McCarron** shot 68 on Sunday and finished T31 at 5-under. The best finish by a DICK'S Sporting Goods Open defending champion was T14 by Bart Bryant in 2014, and a defending champion has not won on PGA TOUR Champions since the 2017 Regions Tradition, a span of 35 tournaments.
- **Billy Mayfair** closed with an 8-under 64, 11 shots better than his 75 on Saturday. It was the fourth time he shot 64 on PGA TOUR Champions, and he finished T31 at 5-under.
- **John Daly** (hip) withdrew prior to the start of the final round.
