BERNHARD LANGER (-10)

Q. Really impressive round today, a couple close birdie putts missed on 14 and 15. Can you talk about those a little bit?

BERNHARD LANGER: Yeah. I made a couple important ones and then I missed a couple important ones, especially the one on 16. I hit three really good shots and had about a six-footer, something like that, and I just didn't hit it hard enough, it broke away.

Yeah, I had a couple other chances, too. It's not easy. These greens are maybe some of the hardest greens to read of all the greens we play, at least that's what I find. I saw a couple other guys shake their heads, too. They putted left edge and it breaks left, stuff like that. It's weird.

Q. Was the wind a factor for you today?

BERNHARD LANGER: Definitely, the wind made it a lot hardier. I think that's why the scores are higher today, it was cold and quite windy, 15 gusting to 20 and that always makes it tough.

Q. Did it make it harder to execute?

BERNHARD LANGER: Well, it just makes it harder to get the ball close to the hole and guess the right club. Early on I was between clubs a few times and some of the pins were tucked away, so it wasn't easy and the wind certainly didn't help.

Q. What do you take from here going to next week?

BERNHARD LANGER: I played solid. Most of my game was solid. Today I had a couple of loose iron shots early on, but then found the swing in the middle of the round and gave myself opportunities. So overall, first last week, second this week, so it's pretty positive.

Q. Woody winning and Fran Quinn doing what he did, it's kind of a feel good, guys that have been farther in the pack. What do you have to say about those guys?

BERNHARD LANGER: Well, I think Woody's been knocking on the door several times this year. I remember him leading in Pebble a few weeks ago and then he messed up or whatever. But he's a great player. He's got a wonderful swing, it's just a matter of whether he makes a few putts or not. It's like that with 80 percent of the guys out here. Anybody and everybody, if they're on their game, they can pull it off.
