Q. So very good, bogey-free round today.

JOE DURANT: Yeah, very pleased with that. I had a lot of good shots, hit a lot of greens, which is what you have to try to do is hit the ball solid on a day like today. The only time I really thought of making bogey was on 17. I hit it in the front bunker and I holed it, so I made birdie. That was a nice gift there.

It was tough. It was cold, it was raining off and on. You're trying to figure out how to layer, what layers to take on, keep off. It's always a juggling act really.

Q. Does putting a round like this together on a day where it's as tough as it is, does it add value to what you take out of it?

JOE DURANT: Yeah, if you can go bogey-free on a day like today, yeah, you definitely pull something out of it. You played solid golf, probably got a few good breaks, a few up-and-downs, but I'm very happy with how I played today.

Q. You got a win a couple weeks ago. Are you still feeling the residual effects of that victory?

JOE DURANT: It didn't show last week. I mean, I played okay, but I didn't make any putts last week. You don't want to have a good week and then just kind of skate for the next bunch of weeks, you want to keep trying to ride that momentum, so that's what I'm trying to do right now.

Q. And you've got to feel good knowing that you've been in this position very recently heading into tomorrow?

JOE DURANT: Yeah, right. That's all you ask for is just opportunities. I feel good about my game. It will be a shootout tomorrow, some good scores. Weather's supposed to be good, so it will be a nice Sunday.
