

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW

TOMMY TOLLES (-10)



Q. Started off really strong, five birdies on the front nine. What was working for you there?

TOMMY TOLLES: I think the softer conditions really helped. I played a little bit too conservative the first couple days, playing for the ball to bounce forward, trying to leave it in the right spot to where you don't have to fret over the next shot.

Today, you know, we were a little bit more in control. It was a little bit more point and click, which is what I'm a little bit more used to. Thinking for the most part I was rolling the ball really well, too.

Q. 65, pretty good score. Did you have a score in your mind going into today?

TOMMY TOLLES: I thought if we could get to 12 it would take everybody out of the equation.

Q. That would have done it.

TOMMY TOLLES: I had a birdie putt there at 16 that I hit just a little too hard, and 17 I almost topped my first one, I hit it so poorly.

Q. The putt or the --

TOMMY TOLLES: The putt, yeah. No, the iron shot wasn't my greatest, but --

Q. You didn't get much of a break on it?

TOMMY TOLLES: Another two or three yards or whatever, it would have stayed up top. You never know how many bites at the apple you're going to get out here, and when you get a big chomp at it, you've got to make the most of it. I'm really disappointed even though I finished the way I did.

Q. It's a good finish, it's another good finish, but is the overriding feeling you get from a tournament like this, is it a good one, because you've got a couple of good tournaments in a row, a couple of top-10s?

TOMMY TOLLES: Obviously I never won on the PGA Tour, so this is kind of like -- you've heard that adage about same movie, same script, same ending? I have a little bit of that feeling, which is not a good feeling to have.

So I don't know how many times you have to get in the competition or whatever before you can actually pull it out. Time's limited, you've got to make the most of it. You know, I don't know what to do. Right now I'm just really disappointed because things could have been so much easier, just two little six-footers on 17 and 18 there and my whole world changes. But I guess that's golf.
