SCOTT PAREL (-7)

Q. Close birdie putt there?

SCOTT PAREL: Yeah, yeah. It was -- you know, I made some, I missed some. That's golf, yeah.

Q. After the eagle, it was a little bit of a grind it seems like, but you hung in there. Talk a little bit about that back nine.

SCOTT PAREL: You know, after the eagle I felt like that was the perfect club, and then from then on in it felt like I was in between all day. So that's a lot of it is being comfortable that the club you've got is the right one every time. You know, probably tried to force the club on the next hole a little bit and then, you know, hit a good shot here and there. It was a little scrappy at the end, but I gave myself three, four good chances the last four holes, hit good putts, just didn't make them.

Q. And certainly in good position going into tomorrow, obviously just one shot back?

SCOTT PAREL: Yeah, sure. I mean, you can't win today, so just get in position and try to play, you know, like I've been playing on Sundays, which has usually been pretty decent, so we'll see.

Q. Will you be any more aggressive tomorrow or just kind of take what the course is giving you? What's the kind of strategy going in?

SCOTT PAREL: "Smartly aggressive" is kind of how I'm trying to be here. You know, it's a fine-edged sword, you know, do you try -- there were a couple times today where we took chances that we didn't take yesterday, going for it on 16 and it's all about how you're feeling at the time. Like I said, depending on what the numbers are, if you feel like you've got good numbers, then be aggressive; a little bit not so sure, maybe be a little bit more conservative.
