

FINAL ROUND INTERVIEW

KENNY PERRY (-8)

Q. Great round today. Is that what you anticipated this morning when you got here?

KENNY PERRY: Any time you anticipate something you shoot 80, so it just happens. I played nice. I was in the situation where I had everything to gain, nothing to lose. I was in the no-stress zone out there.

Q. Did you see it coming the first couple of days?

KENNY PERRY: Been playing nice, yeah. I drove it nice the first two rounds and didn't putt very well yesterday. I putted better today. I worked on a couple things and it seemed to pay off and work. Struggled on the last couple holes, but we got 'er in, got it done.

Q. You took advantage of the par 5s for most of the round and then ironically the last par 5 kind of --

KENNY PERRY: I had 142 yards and hit a pitching wedge and flew the green. I guess I was pumped up.

Q. Nice to come back and get a birdie, though, on 18 to close the gap?

KENNY PERRY: It was a par. I hit it in the woods, chipped out, knocked it on and made the putt. I'm 8-under. I think Scott's 10. I don't see him or Goydos coming back. But it was a good week, I'm very happy.

Q. Will you wait around at all just to see?

KENNY PERRY: No, I'm going to catch my Delta flight. I'm playing Vegas, the Tour event, next week. So I'm going to Vegas to play the Tour event, so I'm on the road.
