

JERRY KELLY (-8)

Q. So how much did last week help you this week?

JERRY KELLY: Last week helped a lot just to prepare because I took my first two months off since probably 1989 when I turned pro, so I only practiced for one week. I didn't even play 18 holes a day. I was in California. So I played really well last week. If I would have puttied like I did today, I would have won easy. So I took that into this week. Switched back to my old putter and had a good day on the greens.

Q. Four rounds in the 60s last week, too?

JERRY KELLY: Yeah, I mean, yeah. I love the islands. I have fun over here every single time and this is where I come to prepare for the season.

Q. First tour of duty on this course, not bad, 8 under?

JERRY KELLY: This is my first tournament round here, but I've played many rounds here. This is where I prepare for the Sony. Been coming here for years and it still didn't help me get in the tournament last year. I couldn't, so I had to fight my way in here and it felt good to do that. I've played here a lot.

Q. So you know it?

JERRY KELLY: I know it. Not as well as I know tournament courses, though. That's the strange thing. I'm hitting it out in spots, like that's fine, that's got to get left. I get down there and I was like man, I thought there was more room. We definitely pay more attention. The second you play one tournament round, I know where everything is, but I've just been playing with my brother-in-law for years out here, just hitting shots. The wind's different all the time, you know that. So a few things surprise me, but the greens I know.

Q. Did you birdie six of the last nine?

JERRY KELLY: I don't know. You know more than me.

Q. I'll let you know. Did you keep your eye on the scoreboard at all? Rocco came in at 7, you got to 8.

JERRY KELLY: Yeah, yeah, I didn't know I got to 8 until I got to 18. I said I really want to -- I definitely want to -- yeah, more time to rest.
