Q. What was the read on that putt? It looked pretty straight.

SCOTT PAREL: It was like a right center.

Q. How fun is Sunday shaping up to be here?

SCOTT PAREL: Yeah, it's going to be great, I think. Obviously I'm going to have to shoot a pretty low score again tomorrow to have a chance. Should be -- you know, if the weather holds in there, I think it will be a great day.

Q. Is it drying out out there? Is the course playing faster than it did yesterday?

SCOTT PAREL: You know, the fairways are definitely a little drier. We got a little more bounce like we're used to seeing, but the greens are still really receptive.

Q. The fact you've been in a playoff, is that going to help tomorrow that you've been that close to winning, or does it matter?

SCOTT PAREL: I don't think it really makes a difference. You know, I've won before, so playoff, no playoff, whatever, I don't think it makes a difference.

Q. How do you think you played today overall? Are you happy with your play on the course?

SCOTT PAREL: You know, yesterday I didn't feel like I left any shots out there. Today I felt like I played much better and only scored one shot better, so I probably left a few out there today, which that's good, so you've got room to improve maybe tomorrow.

Q. How do you feel heading to the final round knowing you're near the top of the leaderboard?

SCOTT PAREL: You know, like I said, no matter where you are, you're going to have to shoot a low score to win. I'm sure Tom's going to be 14, 15 under going into tomorrow. You probably got to get close to 20 under maybe, I don't know. It depends, I guess, on how it turns out. No matter where you are, you've got to try to make as many birdies as you can on this tour.
