Q. Obviously not the way you wanted to finish there on 18, but how did you feel about your round today overall?

COREY PAVIN: I played well today. It was a good round. Obviously I didn't want to bogey the last hole. I thought I hit a pretty good shot in there so I was a little surprised. I made a couple good putts here and there and played pretty solidly, so I was pretty happy with the way I played and got one more day to go tomorrow.

Q. What has to go right for you tomorrow to put yourself at the top of that leaderboard?

COREY PAVIN: I just have to go out and keep playing, doing what I'm doing. I can't force the issue and you never know what everybody's going to do. So I'll just go out there and play the best I can and see where I end up.

Q. Is it exciting to look up at the leaderboard and see all those big names up there with you kind of in contention?

COREY PAVIN: I'm just glad to see my name up there for a change. It's been a while. I played well last week at the Senior PGA, or two weeks ago, so I'm starting to play better and I can only control what I do. So I'll just try and do the best I can tomorrow, see what happens.

Q. Obviously the focus is on tomorrow, but with the U.S. Open being at Shinnecock next week, what do you remember about your victory there? That 4-wood shot obviously comes to mind for most people, but what do you remember about it?

COREY PAVIN: Well, I remember I finished something that I wanted to accomplish, to win a major championship, and I finally got it there. That was the biggest thing I took away from the week was getting something accomplished, a goal that I wanted to get and I got it. You know, the way I did it is the way I did it, but I was glad to have won a major championship.
