

ROUND 1 INTERVIEW

BERNHARD LANGER (-4)

Q. How did you start off today with that weather? How bad was it?

BERNHARD LANGER: It wasn't bad at all. There was not much wind. It was a little cool, but not -- I've seen a lot worse. It was quite comfortable.

Q. What was maybe a key shot or a key moment of today?

BERNHARD LANGER: Nothing really. I just played really solid. Had a lot of opportunities, could have been 8 under and finished 4 under. That three-putt on the last was not good, either. Played very solid. I think I hit just about every green in regulation.

Q. What about playing with your junior?

BERNHARD LANGER: Christina. It was fun, she played really good. She eagled No. 18 there and had another birdie somewhere, so she played really solid.

Q. And then moving on to tomorrow, what does that look like? What's your mindset different from today or the exact same. Give me something here, Bernhard.

BERNHARD LANGER: Well, there is no different mindset. I'm trying to go as low as I can. You're trying to play smart-aggressive. You don't want to take on ridiculous shots, but you need to hit good shots, too, and have opportunities. We're only one round into the tournament, so tomorrow's no different. You want to go as low as you can without making any major hiccups and hopefully have a chance going into Sunday and that's the whole goal.

Q. How hard is that to play two different courses, two different styles?

BERNHARD LANGER: It's a little different, yeah, because the greens are different. Over there we had poa annua, this is -- I don't know what this is, but they're speed-wise kind of similar, but these are very undulated and very large and Pebble is kind of small and still slopy. So different golf course. Always have to hit the ball where you're looking and get it close, you know that.
