Q. So bogey-free round. Can you just talk about your mindset going into today from yesterday?

GARY HALLBERG: Yeah. I had have good control over my ball the first two days and I was pretty much hitting it where I was looking. So I just went up to each shot, hit it the best I could and I made some good putts, some par putts. If I missed the green, I got it up and down and drove it real well. I mean, I've got some good scores, so playing pretty consistently so far.

Q. Right. Was there maybe a shot today or a moment that you remember thinking, okay, here's some momentum into the rest of the round?

GARY HALLBERG: Yeah, let's see. If I think about that, I was just steady all day. I had lots of birdie putts, just birdie putt on most holes it seemed like. Let's see. No, it was just overall just a consistent round, low stress.

Q. Have you played better here or do you feel like this was one of your best round here?

GARY HALLBERG: It was one of my best rounds. I've had some lower scores, but today the wind was blowing this morning, so it was a little tricky. It's firm, so when it's firm, the greens are firm and it makes it a little bit harder.

Q. And how was playing with your junior, what's that vibe like?

GARY HALLBERG: It's great. He went out there and he hit a lot of good shots. I think we had a lot of fun. I think he made the cut, too, which was good.
