**Q. You're in at minus 7 through 36 holes.**

**DUFFY WALDORF:** Yeah.

**Q. Your thoughts on how it went here at Poppy today?**

**DUFFY WALDORF:** Well, Poppy, the ball's running a lot at Poppy, it was playing nice. The wind picked up I would say on the back side, made it a little tougher, but the greens were rolling good. It was nice to get a morning round in. I think it played a little nicer in the morning and I got off to a good start. Didn't finish as well as I would have liked, left a few out there, but played real solid golf and kept it in play. 7 under par, I can't complain about that.

**Q. What do you think it's going to take tomorrow to pull ahead?**

**DUFFY WALDORF:** Well, Pebble, always a lot can happen at Pebble. Conditions always dictate the scoring, but the key to Pebble's getting off to a good start. My best rounds at Pebble are when you get those first seven holes. So really the key is to see how many birdies you can get out of the box and then see where you stand and play in from there.

**Q. It's a special week playing with juniors. Just your thoughts on the format and how much you enjoy playing with The First Tee kids?**

**DUFFY WALDORF:** Well, it's pretty neat. It's amazing, it's been six years and I've been getting a lot of kids from Sacramento and they kind of have a pipeline.
