MARCO DAWSON (-9)

Q. Maybe not the outcome you wanted today, but you still have to be overall pleased?

MARCO DAWSON: Oh, yeah, I'm very pleased. I did not make a lot of putts even though my score -- you know, I had a pretty good score. I hit the ball really good the first two days, could have been I can't tell you how many more shots better if I had just made half the putts from 12 feet that I missed. Yeah, I'm happy with it. It feels good going into the last four events.

Q. Are you surprised the scores didn't go lower today?

MARCO DAWSON: No, no, because the -- to me, the greens were a little firm, a little too firm, and so there were some holes that you couldn't even -- I mean, you could barely keep a ball on the green with a wedge. If you hit anything more than a wedge, you're going to bounce -- if you land on the green, you're going to bounce over. You know, that's somewhat goofy.

And then a couple holes the greens were kind of soft in the front. When you try and land it short, it hit and it stopped. You've got to battle some inconsistencies sometimes. For the most part I thought it played pretty well. It was firm and it played good.

Q. What will you take home after playing with your junior this week? Is there any special moments, highlights?

MARCO DAWSON: Yes. They get overwhelmed out here and they try. They try as hard as they can, you know. You wish you could help them, "I want you to hit it here" or "I want you to do this," but you can't pull the trigger for them, you've just got to watch them. Sometimes it hurts and sometimes it's great. It's fun with the kids.
