DUFFY WALDORF (-8)

Q. Are you surprised the scores didn't go lower today in these final groups?

DUFFY WALDORF: Well, not really. I mean, sometimes Pebble Beach, it's a tough golf course. They're having the U.S. Open here next year. Greens got firm and the wind picked up enough that I think it made it tough. And the wind was picking up and dying, so it was hard to get out there. You had to get on the course early and I got on the course pretty early. I missed a couple opportunities and made a double bogey, but I felt like I should have been 4 under on the front. That was the difference for me. The back side never plays that easy out here. Birdies were tough. There are a few birdie holes, but overall it was a tricky day out there.

Q. As far as playing with your junior for the week, I know it makes it a special experience. What will you take away from it?

DUFFY WALDORF: Well, now it's my sixth year. It's really neat to see, just to be a part of the moment in life, one of their probably highlights of certainly their early life and it's great to be part of it and great to see them enjoy it.
