ROUND 2 INTERVIEW May 18, 2018

JERRY KELLY (-9)



Q. Just kind of talk about this round here and what do you walk away from this round with?

JERRY KELLY: I didn't hit it as well as yesterday and had a couple short-side mistakes, got most of them up and down. Put one in the water, couldn't get that one up and down. So a fairly good round, just couldn't get anything going, couldn't put a string of birdies together or anything. Just treading water a little bit too much for this field.

Q. Any big changes in the course that was real noticeable or had an impact on your game at all?

JERRY KELLY: Played a little longer today than it did the whole week, and then the wind was up and it was kind of switching back and forth a little bit, so it caught me a couple times. But it's still straightforward, right out in front. If you hit it well, you should be able to hit fairways and greens.

Q. You're in position to win here.

JERRY KELLY: Yep.

Q. You've got to finish out strong, though.

JERRY KELLY: Absolutely. I'm happy with four-day events, probably still a little more used to that than the three-day. Found myself pacing myself out there probably a little bit too much because still these guys are used to three days and hitting it hard. So yeah, next couple days, let's get after the birdies.

Q. Last question, you called the official over there. Can you explain what was going on there?

JERRY KELLY: I put my ball down on the putting green and it rolled two feet closer to the hole after I walked away. I didn't cause the ball to move, so wherever the ball goes, that ball is now in play. If it would have rolled off the green into a bunker, that would have been too bad, too, but it rolled a little closer to the hole and I still didn't get it there.
