Q. You got to love it when you get to see your friends.

JOE DURANT: Absolutely. I went to school just down the road in Montgomery, college, and guys I played junior golf with, too, came out to watch me play a little bit.

Q. I got to ask, what is it about 18 that you like, because you seem to have that number?

JOE DURANT: Well, today I got really lucky, because I pulled my second shot, and I didn't think it would carry the water to be quite honest, but it did. And I took advantage and made a good putt. And, you know, see what happens tomorrow.

Q. You're five or four behind heading into the final round. Is the approach to be aggressive early on and see where it's at, or how do approach that?

JOE DURANT: You know, around this golf course, you got to pick your spot, because there's some tricky holes. No. 3 is tricky, 4 is tricky, 5 is tricky, right out of the gate. I'm just trying to give myself an opportunity. The greens are rolling great. If you hit some good putts, you will make a bunch of birdies, so just going to try to do that tomorrow.

Q. Do you have a certain number you have to go out tomorrow and be?

JOE DURANT: I have no idea, but it will be really low one. Miguel is a great player, and we have some other great players right behind him, so it's -- for us to come from way behind like that will take a really great number.
