Q. Just really quickly, your interpretations of your round?

GENE SAUERS: I just didn't hit it that good today. I started off pretty bad, made bogey on the first hole and kind of got behind the 8 ball kind of quick, and then birdied 2, and made a great ball on 3 and 4, and just kind of wasn't getting into it today or something.
